



## Walter T. Stalcup

January 19, 1943 - March 17, 2018

Walter T. Stalcup, age 75, of Bloomsburg, passed away on Saturday, March 17, 2018, a patient at Geisinger Medical Center in Danville. Walter was a resident of his home in Bloomsburg for over 10 years and previously resided in Plainsboro, NJ for 62 years. He was born on Tuesday, January 19, 1943 in Elizabeth, NJ, a son of the late Frank M. and Beatrice (Mabee) Stalcup. Throughout his younger years, Walter attended the Princeton area schools, and later graduated from Princeton High School, Princeton, NJ in 1961. 
